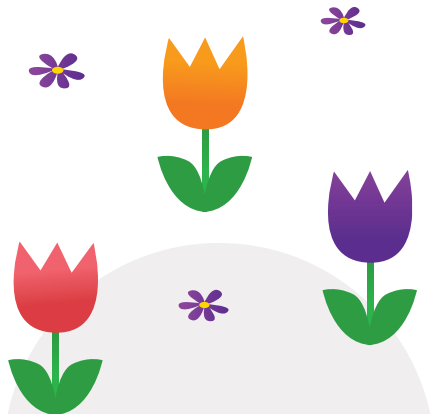

## ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER

### Morning Time

While on the go, look for Easter decorations. Bunnies, chicks, eggs, crosses, candy, flowers...all the things. Every time you see something, say, "Jesus is alive!"

### Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, [name of child] and I want to celebrate Your Son, Jesus, because that's what Easter is all about. Yay, Jesus!"

### Bath Time

Lay a dry washcloth on your child's head, letting it fall just over the tops of their eyes. Say, "1...2...3..." and pull the washcloth away, as you say, "Jesus is alive!" Repeat this, encouraging your child to say, "1...2...3...Jesus is alive" with you.

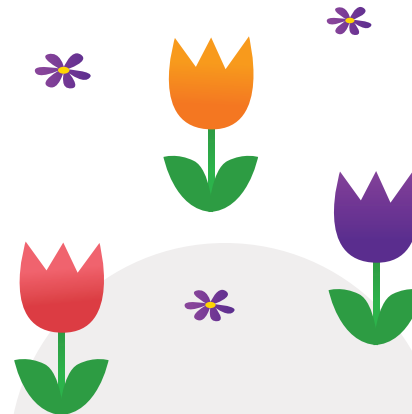
